

Annie Gray is a food historian with degrees from Oxford, York and Liverpool, which include a PhD in Historical Archaeology. She works across the heritage industry as a consultant on food and dining, mainly focusing on the 18th and 19th centuries. She works as a costumed interpreter, which includes representing cooks and kitchen maids in the Georgian and Victorian periods and is the author of a number of articles, both academic and popular. She lectures widely, for history societies, Historic Royal Palaces, English Heritage and NADFAS.
