

David Bostwick (MA, PhD) specialises in the Cultural History of the Medieval, Tudor and Stuart periods, in medieval imagery and in interior furnishings and decoration from 1400 to 1700. A former Keeper of the Social History Collections of the Sheffield City Museums, he established the Bishops' House Museum, which contains a selection of fine regional furniture from the 17th century. He is a consultant for the National Trust, English Heritage and Historic Scotland and is also a specialist advisor on decorative plasterwork and carved woodwork of the 16th and 17th centuries. In addition to leading study tours, he is an established lecturer for NADFAS, the National Trust and art and garden societies. He is also a visiting lecturer and teacher for the universities of Glasgow, York and Sheffield and tutors periodically at the University of Hartford USA.
