

Peter is an author, historian, high-profile event organiser and a recognised authority on Admiral Lord Nelson. He specialises in naval, maritime and polar history. He chairs the 1805 Club, which conserves the monuments of the Georgian sailing navy; the New Waterloo Dispatch (Waterloo 200), the official body that arranged the bicentenary commemorations for Waterloo in 2015, and is now, through cross-culture, celebrating the Idea that is Europe; and Thames Alive, which is re-introducing pageantry to the River Thames. In 2012 he arranged the manpowered squadron of Thames Diamond Jubilee Pageant and the Thames Olympic Torch Relay. He is also a founder and Trustee of Gloriana, the Queen's Row Barge. As vice-chairman of the Official Nelson Commemorations Committee, he played a key role in the planning of the Trafalgar Festival and Sea Britain 2005. Peter lectures widely in the UK, not only for the Arts Society, but also at schools, universities and defence establishments, as well as overseas, and on sea voyages.
